**Effective Fall 2010**

Division of Journalism students are required to complete a minimum of 125 semester hours to earn a Bachelor of Science degree in Journalism or Public Relations. (If enrolled prior to Fall 2005, then 128 semester hours are required.) A student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 to be admitted to the program. To graduate, a student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.4 and a minimum 2.5 GPA in major courses.
