POTENTIAL GRADUATE ACTION ITEMS:

- Review your Academic Requirements in iRattler.
 (All requirements should be collapsed which indicates being SATISFIED)
- 2. Submit Documents via Outlook Forms to your academic advisor.

You will need your FAMU login credentials to complete this process

- Graduation Audit Form. https://rb.gy/cinn52 (Copy and Paste)
- Student Intent to Graduate Form. (Scan QR Code)
- Unofficial Transcript.



- 3. Contact your Academic Advisor to verify receipt of information.
- 4. Department reviews graduation application. (Weekly)
 - If Eligible, Department places ETA Hold (Eligibility to Apply) in iRattler.
- 5. Student applies online via iRattler before university's deadline.

Please adhere to FAMU's academic calendar

- 6. After grades post, Department Chair Approves or Deny graduation application.
 - If Denied, Department Chair e-mails student to their FAMU E-mail.

Forms are located on FAMU School of Journalism and Graphic Communications Department Website

Commencement participation does not guarantee graduation. Student must complete all academic requirements and earn a minimum 2.0 G.P.A. for degree confirmation. All transfer credits must be posted, incomplete (I) grades must be changed to a letter grade and all balances must be cleared (\$0) to receive your degree.
